## PRÉSENTATION

The 11th International Seminar "Forum UNESCO - University and Heritage" organised by the University of Florence, Italy, will introduce research works conducted on documentation and valorization of the architectonic assets. It will also include documentation of tangible and intangible cultural heritage as well as of museology.

Scientific knowledge, work and documentation about architecture and urban environment, the relationship with territory, as well as tangible and intangible heritage, become formidable tools to the comprehension and exploitation of the universe of data and signs given by history and culture, regarding in substance human life that found and takes place in a certain geographic area.

The implementation of academic programmes constitute the fundamental basis for fulfilment of critical and explanatory activities, linked to the creation and development of a specific settlement, city or territory, while they concur to the expectation of the required planning interventions for preservation and exploitation with the main purpose of supporting the human activities.

The purpose of this Seminar is to make a comparison between the experiences implemented in scientific context, that let the setting-up of working methods usable in research for a proper comprehension of architecture, of historical and archaeological sites, of urban environment and of the whole territory, as well as historical, cultural and environmental contexts under research, with the final result of obtaining essential instruments for a critical reading and careful evaluation of preservation and restoration actions in these fields.

Le XIe Séminaire international de Forum UNESCO - Université et patrimoine organisé par l'Université de Florence, Italie, présentera les travaux de recherche sur la documentation et la mise en valeur des éléments architecturaux. Il inclura aussi la documentation du patrimoine matériel et immatériel ainsi que celle de la muséologie.

Les connaissances scientifiques, les travaux et la documentation sur l'architecture et l'environnement urbain, la relation avec le territoire, de même que sur le patrimoine matériel ou immatériel, deviennent des outils formidables à la compréhension et à l'exploitation de l'univers des données et des signes offerts par l'histoire et la culture, qui concerne, dans le fond, la vie humaine qui se crée et se déroule dans un certain espace géographique. La mise en oeuvre de programmes universitaires constitue la base fondamentale pour réaliser des activités critiques ou explicatives, liées à la création et au développement d'un établissement humain spécifique, d'une ville ou d'un territoire, tout en concourant aux attentes en matière de planification pour la préservation et l'exploitation, avec pour objectif principal de contribuer aux activités humaines.

L'objectif de ce Séminaire est de faire une comparaison entre les expériences mises en oeuvre dans un contexte scientifique, laissant le cadre des méthodes de travail utilisables dans la recherche pour une compréhension appropriée de l'architecture et des sites historiques et archéologiques, de l'environnement urbain et du territoire tout entier, de même que les contextes historiques, culturels et environnementaux explorés par la recherche, avec pour résultat final d'obtenir des instruments essentiels pour une lecture critique et une évaluation attentive des actions de préservation et de restauration dans ces domaines.

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## PRESENTACIÓN

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El 11º Seminario Internacional de "Forum UNESCO - Universidad y Patrimonio" organizado por la Universidad de Florencia, Italia, introduce los trabajos de investigación sobre documentación y valoración de los bienes arquitectónicos. También incluye la documentación del patrimonio cultural tangible e intangible así como de museología. El conocimiento científico, el trabajo y la documentación sobre arquitectura y el entorno urbano, la relación con el territorio así como el patrimonio tangible e intangible, se convierten en herramientas formidables para la comprensión y explotación del universo de datos e indicios proporcionados por la historia y la cultura respecto a la vida humana que aparece y tiene lugar en una cierta área geográfica.

La aplicación de programas académicos constituye la base fundamental para la realización de actividades críticas y explicativas, que unidas a la creación y

desarrollo de una instalación concreta, ciudad o territorio, se enfrentan a las expectativas de las intervenciones de planificación requeridas para la preservación y explotación con el propósito principal de apoyar las actividades humanas.

El propósito de este Seminario es hacer una comparación entre las experiencias llevadas a cabo en un contexto científico que permita el establecimiento de métodos de trabajo útiles en la investigación para una comprensión apropiada de la arquitectura, de sitios históricos y arqueológicos, de entornos urbanos y de todo el territorio, así como contextos históricos, culturales y medioambientales bajo la investigación, con el resultado final de obtener los instrumentos esenciales para una lectura crítica y una evaluación cuidadosa de las medidas de preservación y restauración en estos campos.




